Egham Band Youth Programme

Background

Following the end of the government-funded music scheme aimed at introducing children to playing musical instruments, The Egham Band started introducing brass music back into our schools.

The project has now been running for nine years. After two years of planning and preparation, we rolled out to St Jude's CofE Junior School, Englefield Green, in Sept 2018, Thorpe CofE Primary School in Sept 2019 and Manorcroft Junior School in 2022.

In the summer of 2020, Egham Training Band was restarted for those members of St Jude's Brass who were leaving St Jude's, providing a place where they could continue to learn as a group and perform in front of an audience. Egham Youth Band was restarted in the summer of 2023, with the more experienced members of the Training Band moving up.

Today

We are currently teaching brass to 130 Year 4 children who started in Sept 2025. We also run three after-school clubs (St Jude's Brass, Thorpe Brass & Manorcroft Brass) for the more advanced in Y4 and also Y5 & Y6 children who have continued to learn brass. Many of those in-school bands are now also at a standard where they play in Egham Training Band; the majority of the Youth Band is made up of members from Secondary School.

This year, the Training and Youth Bands attended the National Youth Champs of Great Britain, where the bands came away with a Merit and Silver Certificate of Achievement respectively.

Future

Not only do we plan to continue the project, but we have ambitions to expand it to other schools in Runnymede when the time is right and funding is in place. It is hoped that we might start teaching at the next school in September 2026.

Fundraising is an important part of our project, as with anything in life, and nothing comes for free. To date, we have raised funds to purchase around 140 cornets, which we will loan the students one each so they can take them home to practice and play together.

It is hoped that we will continue to take the Training and Youth Bands to the Youth Champs annually and are excited to begin planning a tour with the Youth Band to the south coast in Summer 2026.

We are very grateful for the donations we have received and continue to receive, without them, we would be unable to continue running the project and expand into additional schools.
