The Egham Band Youth Brass Project The Story So Far.....

The Youth Brass Project is an idea to introduce opportunities for whole year groups of children to learn to play a brass instrument within school, perform at various events and continue to play after leaving junior/primary school.

To be sustainable, the instruments used during the year have been purchased by The Egham Band to remove costs to either parents or schools. This has been achieved with the generous support of many individuals and organisations.

Children from Year 4 are playing today on their pCornets and pBones which they only started in September 2024 and in our view, their high standard is remarkable for the short time since they first held an instrument. Some of St Jude's Brass are playing on their next level 'metal' instrument which their parents are supporting the hire of.

We look forward to continuing the development of the abilities of St Jude's Brass in Years 5 & 6 with the after-school club.

Later this month, members of St Jude's Brass will have the opportunity to try other brass instruments and, given the chance to continue to play on their current instrument or move onto a different instrument. Opportunities are available for individual learning and preparation for graded exams.

The Egham Training Band, several members who are from St Jude's School, has grown to be over 30 strong and exists to give the children somewhere to play as their ability increases and when they leave their Junior Schools, they can have opportunities to move to the Egham Youth Band and potentially the Senior Band.
